Newbuilding deliveries

During the first two months of this year, two sister vessels, Edzard Schulte and Erika Schulte, were delivered to their owners in Shanghai - Edzard Schulte on 27th January, 2011 and Erika Schulte on 24th February, 2011. Both vessels belong to the 16,500 DWT, IMO-II, chemical tanker series and bear the respective hull numbers JZU 1012 and JZU 1015.

Upon delivery the two vessels joined the Hanseatic Tanker Pool under Bernhard Schulte Hellas (BS Hellas), with BSM UK and BSM Cyprus being the respective ship managers. They are the 6th and 7th chemical tankers built by the JZU shipyard which have been successfully delivered to the Schulte Group. Thanks to the efforts of Schulte Marine Concept (SMC) during the last three years, the quality of the ships has continuously improved.
